## Subject: Virtual Neighborhood Rezoning Meeting for Proposed 21-REZ-17 Destin Phase III Rezoning

Dear Neighbor:

Cary has received a revised application to annex and rezone properties located at 911 and 1045 Lewter Shop Road. The applicant is requesting to apply initial Cary zoning of Residential 12 Conditional Use (R-12-CU) and Watershed Protection Overlay District (Jordan Lake Sub-district) to allow development of a maximum of 40 detached dwellings adjacent to the existing Destin subdivision (zoned R-12-CU) to the northeast. Additional zoning conditions limit the use to detached dwellings and neighborhood recreation and propose a minimum lot size of 17,500 square feet.

# A neighborhood meeting for this rezoning request was previously held on December 1, 2021. Since that time, an additional 4.27-acre property located at 1045 Lewter Shop Road was added to the initial rezoning and annexation request. The increase in property size requires a second neighborhood meeting.

Cary staff facilitates a "neighborhood meeting" to alert property owners of the proposal and provide an opportunity to share any issues with the applicant prior to the formal public hearing. The Town Council public hearing will be held later and property owners within 800 feet of the subject property will be notified by mail prior to the hearing date.
