RE: Virtual Neighborhood Rezoning Meeting for 4224 and 4300 Green Level West Road (22-REZ-26)

Dear Neighbor:

Cary is initiating the annexation and application of initial Cary zoning of two properties located at 4224 and 4300 Green Level West Road. The properties are currently in Wake County's jurisdiction and zoned Residential-40 Watershed. The Town of Cary, owner of one of the properties, is proposing to zone these properties to Residential-20 (R-20) and Jordan Lake Watershed Protection Overlay District. The properties are being annexed to allow for the dedication of right-of-way and the future construction of the Wimberly Road/Yates Store Road Extension north of Green Level West Road.

Cary staff facilitates a "neighborhood meeting" to alert property owners of the proposal and provide an opportunity to share any issues with the applicant prior to the formal public hearing. The Town Council public hearing will be held later and property owners within 800 feet of the subject property will be notified by mail prior to the hearing date.
