Winners

An award and ribbon will be awarded to the highest scoring entry of each category, overall 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place, and People's Choice, for up to 7 total winners. Each winning entry will be on display at the Cary Arts Center throughout December.

Participating

Categories

Adult	18 years of age and older entering individually or as a team
Teen	13-17 years of age entering individually or as a team Participants 18 years of age but still enrolled in high school may compete in the Teen category
Youth	5-12 years of age entering individually or as a team
Family/Group	Team comprised of any combination of Adults, Teens, or Youth

Team Entry

If all individuals working on a team fit under one category, they should apply in that category. If individuals working on a team fit under more than one category, they should apply in the Family/Group category. Distribution of ribbon and splitting of any prize will be left to the team to determine. Only one ribbon is awarded per winning entry.

Communications

The registered competitor, or their guardian for minors, will receive all correspondence regarding the competition. If the individual entering is under 18 years of age, consent from a parent or legal guardian is required in addition to disclosing the minor's date of birth. For youth participants, the contact provided at registration needs to be an adult.

Each participant or team may only submit one entry.

Entry Criteria

Judging

All entries are judged by a group of community representatives selected by Cary. Each category will receive at least one award, in addition to an overall 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place. People's Choice is determined by online public voting, which will be available December 7-15.

Entries are judged based on: overall appearance, creativity/originality, technique/skill, and difficulty.

Size

Entry must be placed on a board base not exceeding 18"x18". A 1/2" or 3/4" plywood base is recommended. Cardboard bases will not be accepted. No element of your entry should extend beyond the edge of the base. Height should not exceed 24". Please include your name and entry title on the bottom of your base.

Materials & Construction

Everything above the base of your entry must be 100% edible. The main structure of your entry must be at least 75% gingerbread. The use of gingerbread house kits is allowed only in the Youth category.

Edible materials are not limited to candies and icings. Use of gum paste, fondant, chocolate, modeling chocolate, royal icing, gelatin, and pressed sugar is encouraged. For safety reasons, techniques using poured hot sugar or isomalt are not allowed in the Youth category.

Non-edible support structures and decorations above the baseboard such a styrofoam, lighting, or plastic figures will disqualify an entry from judging. Non-edible materials can only be used to decorate the sides of the base.

Entries must be solely constructed by the individual(s) entering the competition. Youth competitors may be supervised by an adult but not overly assisted.
