RE: Virtual Neighborhood Rezoning Meeting 24-REZ-12 402 Charles Ct Rezoning

Dear Neighbor,

Cary received an application to rezone approximately 0.34 acres located at 402 Charles Ct. from Town Center Low Density Residential (TC-LDR) to Town Center Medium Density Residential Conditional Use (TC-MDR-CU) with conditions limiting development of the site to a maximum of two detached dwellings. The Watershed Protection Overlay District (Swift Creek subdistrict) will remain.

Cary staff facilitates a "neighborhood meeting" to alert property owners of the proposal and provide an opportunity to share any issues with the applicant prior to the formal public hearing. The Town Council public hearing will be held later and property owners within 800 feet of the subject property will be notified by mail prior to the hearing date.
