Join your neighbors in eliminating pipe clogging materials such as Fats, Oils, and Grease (F.O.G.) and common personal care trash from your home plumbing and our sewer system, where even a small amount can cause big — and expensive — problems.

TURN YOUR F.O.G. INTO FUEL BY RECYCLING YOUR FATS, OILS, & GREASE

Over 1,500 gallons per year of F.O.G. are collected under the Town's residential cooking oil collection program and recycled into clean burning biofuel at a local plant. Join the effort! It's easy to keep grease out of our sewer pipes where it can harden and block our system.

FOLLOW THESE THREE EASY STEPS:

1. COOL



COOL F.O.G. to a safe temperature after cooking.

2. POUR



POUR into a plastic screw-top container and label "Used cooking oil".

3. RECYCLE



CALL Customer Service at (919) 469-4090 to schedule a free curbside pick-up.
Collect at least 1/2 gallon before calling.

DON'T RUSH TO FLUSH PUT TRASH IN ITS PLACE!



When flushed, these items can accumulate in pipes and lead to costly sewer blockages and environmentally damaging overflows. Help keep our sewers running clean by **DISPOSING OF THESE ITEMS IN YOUR TRASH** and not in our sewers.
